Before the digitalisation, the Service Information used to be written on a special Whiteboard.

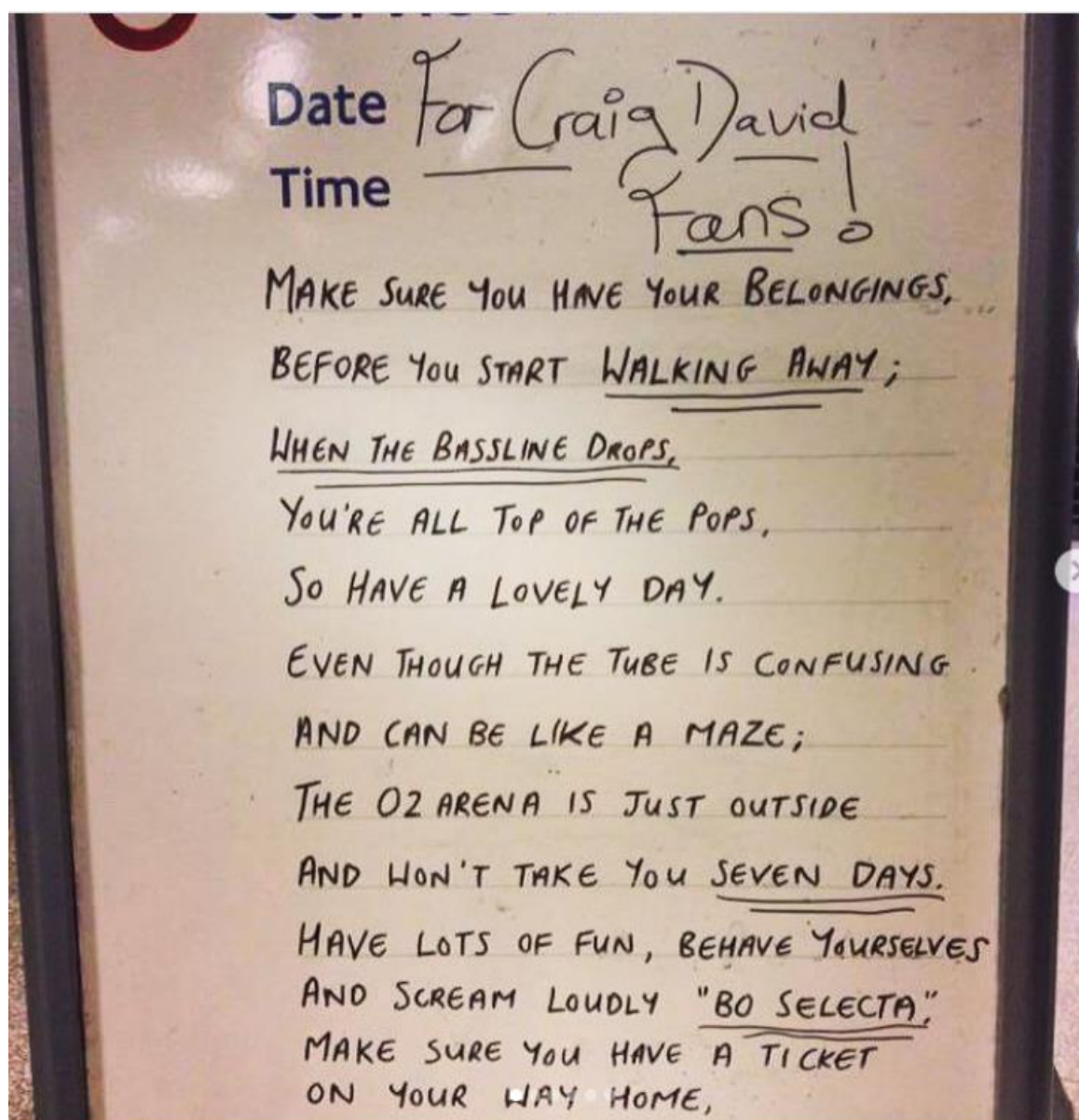
Luckily, these Whiteboards did not become obsolete after the modernisation.

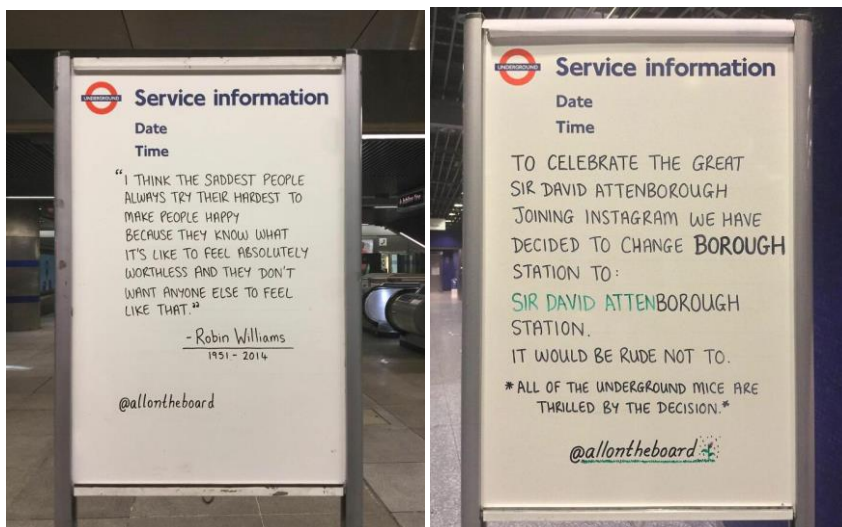
So who is behind these little poems and lovely messages?
