Introduce the excuse generator AI to your students.



In the example below, the message that will be created is between two Coworkers.

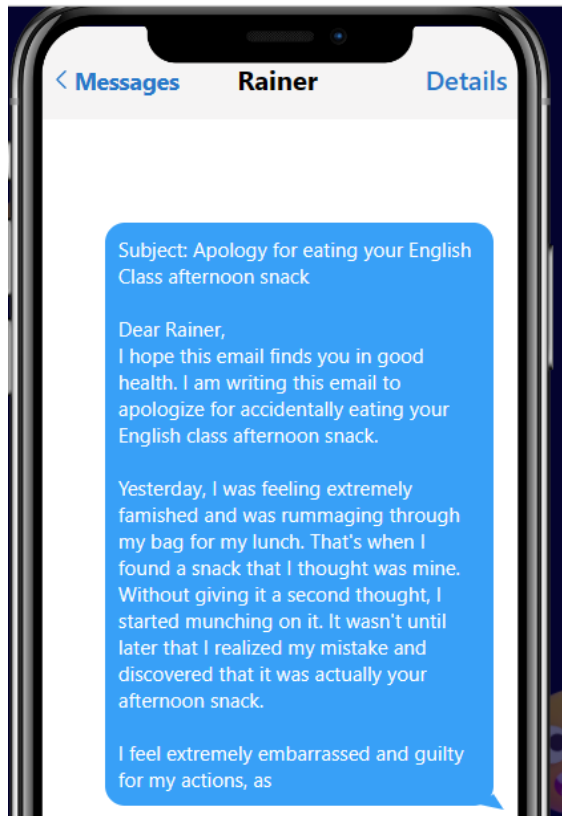
The excuse is directed at 'Rainer'.
