1. Read following transcript of a sketch out loud – best to take turns.

a. What is the setting of the sketch?

The setting is a busy newspaper office where a team of writers, editors, and other staff members are working on putting together a publication.

b. Who are the main characters and what is their job? What went wrong?

Name	Job
Boss	The leader of the newspaper office
Ed	The editor
Colin	The columnist
Rita	The writer
Prue and Fred	The proof readers
Jessica	The photographer
Futtah	The new photo editor

Ed: He is responsible for managing the editing process.

Colin: His column was part of the problem.

Rita: She wrote Colin's column but didn't proofread it.

Prue and Fred: They checked the work but missed mistakes.

Jessica: Her photos were not up to standard.

Futtah: She is the new photo editor promoted to fix Jessica's

mistakes.

c. What is the key problem or situation?



The key problem is that the latest edition of the newspaper is full of mistakes, and the boss is trying to figure out who is responsible while managing the chaos in the office.

d. In the last scene, what should Rita have said instead of 'medic'?

She addressed Amber and Lance to call the medic, but to stay consistent with the rhyming of the sketch she should have said: Amber and Lance, call an ambulance.

e. What was the resolution (if any)?

There is no real resolution. The boss gives out tasks to fix the mistakes collectively but becomes overwhelmed with the chaos and eventually passes out.

3. Rewrite

<u>Scenario</u>: The team is working on a new issue of the newspaper, and they need to ensure everything is correct before publishing. Mistakes from the last issue have caused tension, so this time they are determined to do better.

What could each character say to solve the problem?

Possible solution:

Boss:

"Alright, team! Let's make sure this issue is perfect. Rita, have you finished writing your column?"

Rita (Writer):

"Yes, I wrote it, but I haven't proofread it yet. I'll need someone to double-check."



Prue (Proofreader):

"Don't worry, Rita. Fred and I will proofread it right away. Fred, are you ready?"

Fred (Proofreader):

"Got it, Prue. Let's make sure there are no errors this time!"

Jessica (Photographer):

"I've submitted my photos for the layout. Futtah, can you check if they fit the theme?"

Futtah (Photo Editor):

"Sure, Jessica. I'll re-edit the photos if necessary to ensure they match the article."

Ed (Editor):

"Good teamwork! Let's make sure everything flows smoothly. Remember, this is our chance to redeem ourselves!"
