Answer:

Die With Me – A chat app that only works when your phone battery is 5% or less, so you can talk to other people whose phones are about to die.

Funny Dumb Questions & Beyond – A light-hearted app where users ask and answer silly, random, or “dumb” questions just for fun.

Yuka – An app that lets you scan food and cosmetic products to see how healthy they are.

Is It Dark Outside? – A simple app that tells you whether it’s currently dark outside in your location.

Too Good To Go – An app that helps reduce food waste by letting you buy leftover food from restaurants and shops at a lower price.

The App That Tells You When to Go: RunPee

Have you ever gone to the cinema and suddenly needed to use the bathroom during the most exciting part of the film? Many people have experienced this uncomfortable situation. Missing an important scene can be frustrating, especially if the movie has a complex story. This common problem inspired the creation of RunPee, an unusual but surprisingly useful app.

RunPee was created by Dan Gardner in the United States. The idea came from his wife, who often needed bathroom breaks during long films. Instead of missing key moments, Gardner decided to develop an app that tells users the best time to leave their seat. The app identifies short scenes in a movie that are less important to the overall story. These moments are called "Pee Times."

Before watching a film, users open the app and select the movie they are about to see. The app tells them approximately when a less important scene will happen. It even provides a short summary of what happens during that moment, so viewers can quickly read what they missed when they return. This means they can enjoy the film without worrying about losing important information.

RunPee also includes extra features. For example, it warns users if there are additional scenes after the end credits. Many modern films include bonus scenes, and some viewers do not want to miss them. The app also allows users to rate movies and see other people's opinions.

Although the idea may sound funny, RunPee solves a real problem. Cinema tickets are expensive, and people want to enjoy the full experience. The app shows how technology can offer practical solutions to small but annoying everyday issues.

However, some critics argue that using a phone during a film can disturb other viewers. For this reason, the app suggests dimming the screen brightness to avoid distracting others.

In the end, RunPee is an example of how a simple idea can become a successful digital tool. It may seem unnecessary at first, but for many movie lovers, it has become an essential companion at the cinema.

Answer Key


